MassHealth Managed Care Options 2023

- MassHealth has continued with Accountable Care Organizations in its recently-renewed agreement with the federal government
- Effective April 1st, MassHealth open enrollment period begins along with new ACO options becoming available
- MassHealth anticipates a significant number of members changing plans in April


- There are changes in ACO structures, primary care composition, partnerships, and service areas
- Examples
 - UMass Memorial Health has partnered with Tufts Health Together in an ACO
 - East Boston Neighborhood Health Center exited Community Care Cooperative to partner with WellSense in an ACO
 - Mass General Brigham ACO (AllWays) is transitioning from a Primary Care ACO using MBHP for BH to become an Accountable Care Partnership Plan partnered with Mass General Brigham ACO and Optum for BH
- There are branding changes adding to complexity

Examples:

- BMC Healthnet has become WellSense
- **Beacon Health Options** has become **Carelon**

MassHealth Eligibility Redeterminations (Renewals)

- This overview is about managed care options, but it is important to know about MassHealth eligibility determinations or renewals
- MassHealth is required by the U.S. government to redetermine (renew) eligibility for all members over the next year
- ► For a subset of MassHealth members, redetermination *and* plan enrollment processes will coincide.





Act Now, Stay Covered! Providers can help MassHealth members keep coverage by encouraging them to report address, phone number, email, household, job, income, disability status, or pregnancy changes immediately.

Continuity of Care

- MassHealth is mandating a 90-day "continuity of care" period where members can continue to access care from existing providers, regardless of contracted provider networks. This period begins April 1, 2023
- MassHealth has established a process to ensure prior authorizations and referrals transfer from former plan to new plan
- MassHealth is directing plans to pay for pharmacy and non-pharmacy services in the absence of prior authorizations for specified periods of time and under certain circumstances



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Resources

- Eligibility Verification Systems (EVS)
 - Providers should continue to check EVS daily in the Provider Online Service Center (POSC)
 - Managed care data restrictive messages will be updated to identify which type of health plan the member is enrolled in and plan contact information for Billing, Service Auths, and BH vendors
 - EVS displays current eligibility only so it is not possible to view enrollment changes that will occur on April 1st
